RE: Export Control Classification Number (ECCN)

Dear Valued Machinery and Equipment Supplier,

A wide variety of international business transactions are permitted. Many transactions are absolutely prohibited and many others required licensing or authorization from one of or more of the U.S. government agencies that have regulatory control of exports. These agencies include the U.S. Department of State Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC), the U.S. Department of Commerce Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS), and the U.S. Treasury Department Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC).

In order for Regal to comply with the applicable U.S. export control laws and regulations, Regal requires the supplier to provide the Export Control Classification Number (ECCN).

The Export Control Classification Number (ECCN) categorizes items based on the type of commodity, technology or software and their technical parameters. It is an alpha-numeric designation (i.e., 1A984 or 4A001) used in the Commerce Control List (CCL) to identify items for export control purposes.

An ECCN is different from a Schedule B number, which is used by the Census Bureau to collect trade statistics. It is different from the Harmonized Tariff System, which is used to determine import duties.
